A Message from Our Executive Director: Judith Long

The Free Clinics began serving Polk County in 2008 and has continually deepened our care with that community over the past 12 years.

TFC is inherently collaborative, believing that we can do more together than any one organization can do alone. As TFC was engaging Polk community leaders about the needs for the community, affordable medications was always top of the list. But opening a pharmacy is an extremely expensive endeavor. We began exploring possible relationships with local partners, and St. Luke's Hospital enthusiastically entered into first the conversation, and then a truly innovative relationship.

Pharmacy laws are very strict, appropriately so, but it does mean a bit of a delicate dance to find the right relationship that adheres to the law, meets the needs of the community, and is not unnecessarily burdensome to the organizations involved.

St. Luke's Hospital is the perfect partner with TFC to provide life-saving medications for our neighbors in need. TFC is the legal dispensing pharmacy (which enables access of millions of dollars worth of free medications); St. Luke's Pharmacy is the delivery site. This relationship enables affordable, life-saving medications locally in Columbus, thus reducing the barrier of geography and transportation, and does so in the most fiscally responsible manner possible. Last year, our partnership with St. Luke's provided 2,684 prescriptions valued at \$582,359 to 95 unique patients.

We are excited to deepen our service to Polk County even more, as we open our new office and welcome our neighbors in need. Come visit us at **60 Walker Street, Columbus NC, 28722**.

Expanding Our Footprint in the Foothills

Over the past twelve years, our relationship with our neighbors in Polk County has grown both wider and deeper. As we have added services, we have also cultivated local partnerships, such as the one we have with St. Luke's Hospital. In February 2015, TFC and St. Luke's entered a unique and innovative relationship for pharmacy support. TFC now dispenses prescriptions from our medication supply and transports them to St. Luke's pharmacy for delivery to our patients there. This relationship ensures that TFC patients have local access to medications (no longer having to visit the Hendersonville pharmacy) and that they have access to medication teaching by a pharmacist. Our new, dedicated office in Columbus continues our efforts in removing barriers to healthcare access for our neighbors in need in Polk.

In **2013**, TFC begins community case management program in Polk, with access to 178 health partners (at the time).

In **2015**, TFC begins its pharmacy relationship with **St. Luke's Hospital** in Columbus.

In **2018**, TFC contracts with Polk Consolidated Human Services Agency (CHSA) to provide care coordination to vulnerable DSS clients.

In 2008,

TFC begins serving Polk residents with the adoption of the Community Pharmacy*.

*Polk residents must travel to HVL to pick up prescriptions. In **2014**, federal grant funds enable a **full-time dedicated case manager for Polk**, embedded at Polk Health.

In **2012**, all on-site clinics of TFC open to residents of Polk County.

In **2016**, TFC offers wellness screenings & flu shot clinics in Columbus and Saluda; all TFC programming is now fully accessible to Polk residents.

In **2020**, TFC opens a dedicated Polk County office in Columbus.
